## **THE SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT 2017-2018**

The School Annual Report is a document in black and white prepared under the unerring supervision of the Principal to be presented to the Annual Assembly verbatim for their approval and acknowledgement. The Annual Report of the academic year 2017-'18 including all the activities in the curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular and social domains and the commendable achievements thereof are paraded herewith.

### **RESULTS OF THE AISSE AND AISSCE 2017**

In the AISSE (X) 40 students bagged grade A1 in all subjects, 54 students secured marks between 86% and 95%, 36 of them secured marks between 76% and 85% and the remaining 10 students secured between 60% and 75%.

In the AISSCE (XII), there were 68 distinctions and 47 first classes. Greeshma M G and Fabin F S secured the first place with 95% marks. Sinara S secured the second and J A Jaya Soorya secured the third place in our school.

### **STUDENT-STAFF STRENGTH**

The school re-opened after the summer vacation on the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2017. The student strength of the school is 2339 this academic year.

Pooja B. Pradeep of class XII B is the school leader. We have 96 teachers in the teaching faculty and 40 members in the supporting staff. I take this opportunity to express my profound gratitude to all the staff members for their support and cooperation for making the smooth functioning of the school possible.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AND OTHER EXAMINATIONS**

A school is often judged by its excellence in the academic field. In addition to general teaching, we give a lot of importance to extracurricular activities, which help in exploring and nurturing the innate talents and skills in our students. Every year various scholarship exams are conducted. This year 869 students participated in the PCM scholarship examination. Our school secured the Topper School Award this year also for the remarkable performance in the PCM scholarship examination. In
